# APPLICATION REF: 18/01317/CAN – Windfall, Forder Lane

PROPOSAL: Crown lift on magnolia to 3m above ground level and crown thin Members discussed the application. It was proposed by Cllr. Cawthraw, seconded by Cllr. Davey that this application be deferred until the next BPC meeting and the Parish Tree Warden, Peter Hepworth, is consulted for his opinion on the proposed work. Cllr. Davey reported on and read aloud correspondence received by the neighbour of Bakers Yard from Mr. P. Shears, TDC chief executive. This stated that no action would be taken by TDC to enforce the area is made safe or tidy as the site would be undergoing land transfer towards the end of the month. It was not made clear to who the land was being sold or transferred however members felt that this change should not dictate the action being requested by the neighbour and that BPC should write to TD to support the neighbours request for action.
