		approximately 2m high. The client wishes to remove the trees as they cause
		conflict with neighbouring properties and wishes to reduce future maintenance
		costs in line with their budget.

	PARISH TREE WARDEN	I have looked at the planning proposal and I agree that it is a shame to fell a good
	COMMENTS:	mature tree just because it is in the wrong place! However, I can also appreciate
		that a large tree so close to many properties, will be causing considerable anxiety
		to the property owners, especially with the risk of Ash die back disease a distinct
		possibility.
		I would suggest that a considerable crown reduction might be considered, as Ash
		responds very well to coppicing. This would retain the aesthetic of the tree whilst
		reducing the nuisance to the property owners and neighbours. Just leaving a 2m
		high stump as proposed, is likely to result in a forest of new shoots that will not
		form a satisfactory tree.
